Please remember to apply and participate in all tuition reduction opportunities such as FACTS. Families who apply for FACTS and are verified will receive \$205.00 tuition reduction per family.

The lunch fee rates will remain the same, \$100.00 for one child and \$50.00 for each additional child. Rates above do not reflect lunch fees. When you register your child/children, the rate will be added to your tuition and spread over a period of 11 months. If your child/children do not stay in the school for lunch, please notify Denise Valley, Tuition Coordinator at 215-632-1144.
